



School-Based Identification of Dyslexia in Texas: Intermediate Level

Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children is offering a seminar for dyslexia designees, dyslexia resource persons, assessment personnel and educators responsible for administering tests and performance measures and/or using results to identify students with dyslexia and recommend placement. This seminar is specifically designed for those with some experience in the dyslexia identification process who would like to review, refine and update their knowledge.

The seminar will highlight:

- foundation of the definition of dyslexia as a guide to data gathering and interpretation
- data gathering and data review, including parent and teacher questionnaires
- inclusion and interpretation of early reading assessments, particularly the Texas Primary Reading Inventory (TPRI)
- inclusion and interpretation of Response to Intervention (RtI) data in identification of dyslexia and in progress monitoring of interventions
- student profiles that require more in-depth interpretation for the identification of dyslexia, including those with complications of ADHD and oral language disorders

A certificate of attendance will be provided for documentation of CEUs.

Many previous participants have found the most valuable aspect of the seminar is the opportunity to submit their own difficult and confusing case profiles and data.
