



**Medtronic Patient Visit**  
**Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children**

Prior to the Medtronic Spinal and Biologics Global Sales Meeting in Dallas, more than 50 attendees spent quality time with patients at Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children (TSRHC). Medtronic field personnel and executives toured TSRHC and then collaborated on craft projects with hospital patients.
