The collection is particularly rich in scoliosis treatment innovations, documentation of annual meetings and training programs, and POSNA history.

In addition to the research collection, there is a state of the art exhibit area. The exhibit area highlights the many facets of the research collection by providing museum-quality displays along with an interactive touchscreen television, allowing visitors to view many of the digitized recordings contained within the collection.
