- a review of the laws and guidelines for dyslexia identification and intervention requirements in the public schools of Texas
- examples of accommodations to help the student with dyslexia be more successful in the classroom.

THE BASICS: SCHOOL-BASED IDENTIFICATION OF DYSLEXIA IN TEXAS

This seminar is designed for those Texas educators who are **BEGINNING OR REFINING** their process and procedures for the identification of students with dyslexia for the purpose of placement in dyslexia intervention programs. The seminar will include:

- ◆ an review of the current research-based definition of dyslexia
- ◆ an introduction to test instruments for a dyslexia identification test battery
- ◆ a definition-based paradigm and profile for dyslexia identification
- ◆ the core principles of dyslexia identification, including standards of measurement, data gathering, review of early reading assessments and Response to Intervention (RtI) progress measurements
- ◆ case studies that allow the participants to recognize the characteristic profiles of students with dyslexia and to make decisions regarding placement
- ◆ examples of definition-based teacher and parent questionnaires
